

A Range of Options for Multi-Family Complexes

Allied Waste Services collects garbage at least once a week from all multi-family residential complexes in the City of Pleasant Hill.

Property managers and owners have a range of options to fit the level of garbage service needed for their property. Allied Waste Services can provide:

- Carts. In sizes ranging from 32 to 96 gallons.
- Dumpsters. Available for complexes with larger volumes of refuse in sizes from 1 to 8 cubic yards capacity.

ON CALL CLEANUPS

As part of your garbage and recycling service package, Allied Waste Services will provide you with three (3) 20- to 40-yard debris boxes per year for designated cleanup material.

Cleanup Options

You can choose to have either:

- Three cleanups with one debris box per cleanup;
- Two cleanups with 2 debris boxes for one cleanup and one debris box for the third cleanup; or
- One cleanup using all three debris boxes.

Only a property manager, owner or designated representative may schedule a cleanup. To schedule a cleanup or for more information, call (925) 603-1383.

Unacceptable Items for Cleanups

- No large car parts (tires, transmission blocks, engines, etc.) or large furniture.
- No refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or any other appliance with Freon.
- No appliances such as microwave ovens, space heaters, clothes dryers and others with mercury switches.
- No rocks, dirt, concrete, tree stumps or tree trunks.
- No TVs or computer monitors. You may call (925) 603-1383 to arrange a pickup for a fee, which pays for the disassembly and removal of toxic materials, or go to <http://awsccc.com> and click on "Allied Waste News" for information on free e-waste events.
- No hazardous wastes including paint, oil filters, motor oil, car batteries, anti-freeze, solvents, pesticides, cleaners. For more information call 800-646-1431.

RECYCLING SERVICE

Depending on the service you request or the results of the free waste assessment we conduct at your property, Allied Waste Services will provide your complex one or more clearly marked recycle carts and a bin for cardboard recycling.

Recycling service is provided at no additional charge.

The carts should be in the same location as your refuse carts or dumpsters. Separating recycling materials is not necessary: newspapers, paper and plastic, glass and

metal containers all go into the clearly marked recycle carts. Broken down cardboard goes in the carts if there is not a separate cardboard bin. To recycle:

- Have residents store recyclables in their apartment or condo in a place that is convenient for them. Apartment recycling containers for indoor storage are available

at no charge by calling us at (925) 671-5806.

• When ready, residents can take the recyclables and place them in the clearly marked recycle carts.

Allied Waste Services has recycling guides that you can hand out to residents. If you need any, call (925) 671-5806.

The carts are serviced bi-weekly on the same day as your complex's regular garbage service.

CARDBOARD CLEANUPS

As part of your recycling service, Allied Waste Services will provide you with two (2) on-call cardboard recycling cleanups per year.

Taking advantage of this service is easy. All it takes are three easy steps:

- Step 1: Call (925) 603-1383 at least one week in advance to schedule the cardboard recycling cleanup. This call must be placed either by the property manager, the owner or a designated representative.
- Step 2: Mail or fax a site map of the property to show the pickup location.

- Step 3: We will provide your complex with a letter to distribute to the tenants or residents of your apartment or condominium complex to announce the cleanup.

YARD WASTE SERVICE

Multi-family complexes that generate yard waste may request a green cart for yard waste service by calling an Allied Waste Services customer service representatives at (925) 603-1383.

There is a fee for yard waste service.

Free Waste Assessment

Ask our customer service representative about rates for varying levels of service or call (925) 671-5806 for a free waste assessment to see what level of service your complex requires.

HAZARDOUS WASTES

It is illegal to place hazardous and electronic wastes in the garbage. None of these materials should ever be placed in dumpsters at apartment, condominium and other multi-family complexes.

Property owners of a complex are responsible for the removal of any hazardous or electronic waste in a dumpster, whether generated by the complex or not.

If the hazardous or electronic waste is not removed, Allied Waste Services will charge the complex a hazardous waste disposal fee.

For information regarding what Allied Waste Services considers hazardous and electronic waste, call (925) 603-1383.

Residents of your complex may recycle some hazardous wastes such as oil filters, used motor oil, antifreeze, latex paint, fluorescent tubes and car and household batteries at the following local recycling facilities:

Appliances

State law prohibits putting refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or other appliances with Freon in garbage.

State law also prohibits any mercury-containing appliances such as microwave ovens, clothes dryers, water heaters, furnaces and space heaters in garbage.

Allied Waste Services will pick up hazardous appliances at your property for a fee.

Computer Monitors, Television Sets

State law prohibits putting TVs and computer monitors (CRTs) in garbage. Allied Waste Services will pick up TVs, computer monitors, and electronic waste items at your property for a fee.
